

Private Thomas Isaac Probert

Kings Shropshire Light Infantry



Little is known of the life of Thomas Isaac Probert. His military records show that he was born in Dymock, and there are records of people this family name living in the area at this time, but no records have been found for this man. It is known that he was killed in action on 25 September 1915 on the Western Front. He is recorded on the Menin gate in Ypres, Belgium.

From his military records, it is presumed that he would have been eligible for the award of the medals shown below, but it is not known if they were presented to his family. His family would also have been eligible to receive the Commemorative medal and scroll from HM King George V.

He is not commemorated on any local War Memorial.

His regimental number was 11061, but nothing else is known about this man.
